2016 Cancer Registry Data Review

In 2016 Mon General added 771 cancer patients to our data base. 659 of these were diagnosed and/or treated first course here (analytic). Highlights of the analytic class of case are: 283 patients received diagnosis and all treatment at Mon General, 98 were diagnosed here with part of treatment here and part of treatment elsewhere, 71 were diagnosed elsewhere and had all treatment here, 71 were diagnosed elsewhere and had part of their treatment here, 93 were diagnosed elsewhere and had part of their treatment here, and 24 were diagnosed in a staff physician's office and had all or part of 1st course treatment here. 85 were diagnosed here and received all of their treatment elsewhere.

Of the 659 analytic cases 206 cases were in the age group of 60-69,162 were 70-79, 133 were 50-59, 82 were 80-89 and 40 were 40-49 years of age at the time of diagnosis. Also of interest this year was 24 patients were 30-39 years of age, 8 were over 90, and 4 were 0-29. The mean age for this group was 65.

64% of cases were female and 36% male. Zelda Stein Weiss Cancer Center provided diagnosis and/or first course treatment to these top 5 sites: 140 uterine, 66 breast (female), 65 lung, 51 colon and 47 prostate.

Other top sites seen in 2016 were: 23 hematopoietic, 33 bladder, 30 kidney cases 27 pancreas and 24 ovary cancer cases. The top 10 sites comprised 506 out of our 659 analytic cases. When comparing the top 10 sites AJCC stage at diagnosis we see that 202 cases were diagnosed at stage I, 55 at stage II, 64 at stage III and 76 at stage IV.

Our facility services many counties in WV. The top counties serviced by our cancer center in 2016 were Monongalia 288, Marion 76, Preston 60, Harrison 15, and Taylor 13.We also served 48 patients from PA, 31 from MD and 11 from Ohio.

The Zelda Stein Weiss Cancer Center at Mon General Hospital achieved the Commission on Cancer, Comprehensive Cancer Program Accreditation on August 24, 2016 and achieved 3 year approval.
