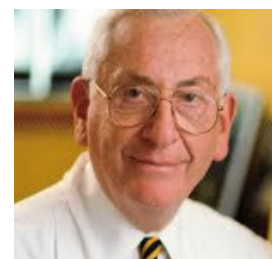

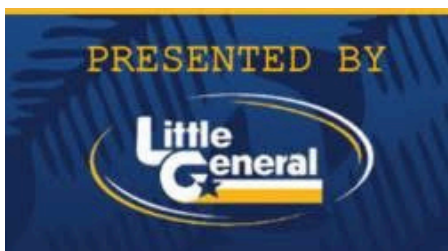

INFUSION PATIENTS FEEL THE DIFFERENCE

Sitting in heated, massage chairs isn't just for the spa. Vandalia Health, in partnership with the Norma Mae Huggins Cancer Endowment, utilized the proceeds from the 2024 Bob Huggins Fish Fry to ensure our infusion patients are the most comfortable they can be during treatment.

Patients were expressing discomfort with the aging infusion recliners, as treatment requires them to sit in for several hours. A total of 44 recliners were recently delivered to Stonewall Jackson Memorial Hospital Infusion Center, Mon Health Medical Center Infusion Center, Davis Medical Center Cancer Care Center, and CAMC Cancer Center-Beckley, providing infusion patients with a more comforting experience.

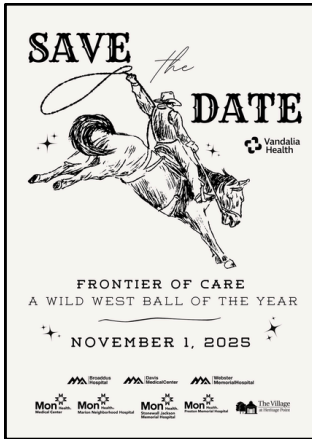

BOB HUGGINS FISH FRY UPDATE



Vandalia Health proudly announced the installation of new state-of-the-art infusion chairs at facilities across the state, thanks to a generous \$150,000 donation from the Norma Mae Huggins Cancer Endowment with proceeds from the 2024 Bob Huggins Fish Fry. The chairs are designed with built-in heat and massage functions, providing comfort during long infusion treatments, and influencing the recovery process.

Bob Huggins personally felt it was important to purchase these upgraded chairs stating, "When I think back to my Mom and what she endured, the patient experience matters greatly."

The 2025 Bob Huggins Fish Fry raised \$660,000 to benefit cancer patients across Vandalia Health. We are grateful and excited to see how the continued support of the Norma Mae Huggins Cancer Endowment will impact cancer care in West Virginia in 2025.

This will allow for a "home away from home" for those going through treatment/procedures, but also families who are under great duress from a loved one's hospitalization. Our new patient/family stay houses are progressing towards reality, with the first one on track to be available this summer. The cottages, which will be situated on Mon Health Medical Center's campus, will offer a welcoming environment and allow families to remain close to their loved ones throughout their medical journeys.



The Caring Cottage project would not be possible without all of our generous donors. The 2025 WVRG Media Golf Classic and DeLynn Memorial Golf Classic raised \$203,500 to support the Progressing through Postpartum (P3) Program.

One in 5 mothers and one in 10 partners experience a perinatal mood disorder such as depression and anxiety during pregnancy and up to a year after giving birth. The P3 program combats these statistics by offering postpartum support services to new families. With screening, early detection, and management of symptoms, we can provide continuous support throughout their journey. And with the addition of Moodr Health, a secure messaging platform, the impact has been substantial with a 43% improvement in mood and anxiety disorder scores.

The Mon Health Medical Center Auxiliary seeded this program in 2019, and again in 2021, with proceeds from the Ball of the Year.

WILD WEST BALL OF THE YEAR - SHOWDOWN!

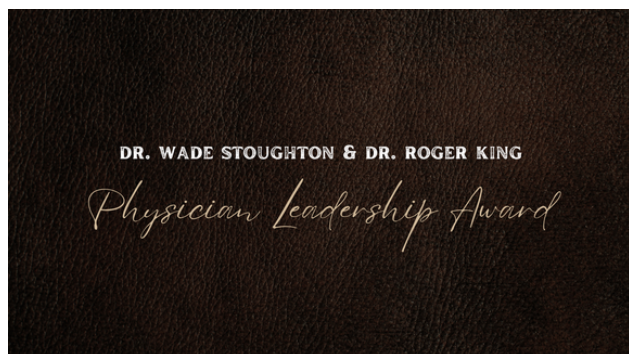

Beam Signing at Preston

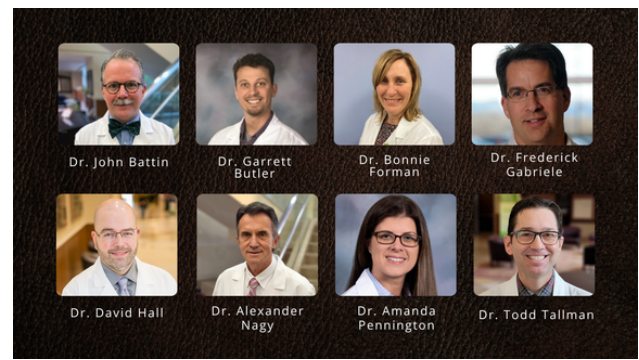
