Our top priorities are providing patients with optimal care and improving lives in any way we can, and in 2023, we saw extraordinary success and truly impacted lives through the generous donations we received.













### P3 Progresses into 2024

Mon Health's Progressing through Postpartum (P3) Program is a comprehensive maternal mental health support program designed to proactively outreach patients and connect them to supportive services. Funded solely by private donations through the 2019 and 2022 Auxiliary Ball of the Year, the P3 program was seeded with over \$500,000.

Through the P3 Program, which was established in January of 2020, mothers are screened before, during, and after pregnancy for any indication of anxiety, depression, or mood disorder. This allows for early detection and management of symptoms, giving the P3 team an opportunity to connect with mothers early on and provide continuous support throughout their pregnancy and postpartum journey. A hallmark of this approach includes reaching out to all patients after delivery, regardless of screening score, to ensure those that are transitioning to parenthood with a new baby are supported and have a source for consistent information.

2023 was a year of significant growth for the P3 Program. Internally, the program has grown its staff to include a full-time



Perinatal Social Worker to follow high-risk pregnancies, and three Perinatal Navigators, one of which is based at Mon Health Stonewall Jackson Memorial Hospital, expanding the program's services to families in Lewis County.

Additionally, the P3 Program established a partnership with Moodr Health in 2023. Moodr Health is a technology innovation designed to streamline and improve the outreach procedures of the P3 Program. This web-based platform incorporates clinicianinput information in a comprehensive dashboard, allows clinicians to schedule outreach, and integrates these metrics to categorize patients by risk level. The platform has improved the efficiency and effectiveness of the program's current outreach procedure by embedding a chat box within the patient profile, displaying relevant metrics alongside this chat box, and allowing multiple clinicians to collaborate on a given patient situation to offer a multidisciplinary approach to meet patient needs.

The P3 Program anticipates continued progress in 2024 with further expansion of services, growing the comprehensive referral network, and implementing their Drug Free Moms and Babies Program, a statewide initiative aimed at addressing substance use during the perinatal period and connecting these patients to treatment services. The team is also excited to present at the Institute of Reproductive Grief Care's Annual Symposium in San Diego, California in March of 2024, focusing on the value of integrated care services and the use of proactive outreach for early identification and treatment of perinatal mood changes.

"We are the first in West Virginia to offer services specific to postpartum depression, anxiety, and mood disorders, and we recognize the importance of supporting families during an overwhelming time in their lives," said Luella Gunter, Executive Director of Philanthropy and Community Affairs. "We are hopeful for the future of this program and will continue to pursue the gold standard in maternal mental health."

### Appalachian Regional Commission supports Mon Pathways to Success with \$493,000 INSPIRE Grant

Mon Health was awarded \$493,000 from the Appalachian Regional Commission (ARC) to support Mon Pathways to Success. Founded in February 2023, this program drives positive systemic change through a transparent, sustainable, and comprehensive program and empowers individuals experiencing homelessness, recovery, or those who have difficulty re-entering the workforce. Graduates complete an extensive six-month educational curriculum covering life skills such as financial management, career development, health and wellness, and connects participants with valuable local resources for ongoing support. As of December 2023, the program has successfully graduated two cohorts.

"At ARC, we know that substance use disorder recovery isn't a singular event, but a continuum. Both workforce training and ending the stigma surrounding substance use disorder are equally important in providing a renewed sense of hope and purpose to Appalachians in recovery," said ARC Federal Co-Chair Gayle Manchin.

"We are so appreciative of Co-Chair Gayle Manchin and ARC for its investment," said David Goldberg, President and CEO of Mon Health System and Executive Vice President of Vandalia Health. "This grant will support the development of jobs and lend a helping hand to those looking to enter the workforce through Mon Health facilities and services. ## Mon Health Preston Memorial Hospital Opens Infusion Center

Mon Health Preston Memorial Hospital opened a new comprehensive infusion center in October, ensuring that patients in rural West Virginia receive quality, close-to-home cancer care. Congressman David McKinley (ret.), along with U.S. Senators Joe Manchin and Shelly Moore Capito, secured \$580,000 in federal appropriations to construct the new facility.

Patients with cancer in Preston County no longer need to leave the region and travel an hour or more over secondary roads to receive customized chemotherapy. The opening of the Infusion Center allows patients to receive treatment in a familiar setting. "Families need to be near patients for such vulnerable care, and this helps us improve care delivery and family support by enhancing the health of the community one patient at a time," said David Goldberg, President and CEO of Mon Health System and Executive Vice President of Vandalia Health.

Melissa Lockwood, Chief Administrative Officer at Mon Health Preston Memorial Hospital, states, "With this new center, we will expand the scope of care we provide in Preston County to better serve local patients in need."

"I understand the difference that having cancer care close-to-home makes in a patient's life," said Dr. Ihtishaam Qazi, Medical Director of Oncology for Mon Health System. "I am proud to serve our patients in Preston County and will continue working to improve the care we provide to ensure better outcomes for our patients."

### Milan Puskar Foundation awards \$300,000 for Spine Clinic at Mon Health Medical Center.

Thanks to a \$300,000 grant from the Milan Puskar Foundation, we can further enhance patient care at Mon Health through our neurosurgical spine program, led by Dr. Houman Khosrovi, and the development of an in-house Spine Clinic. The grant will support the purchase of clinical and surgical equipment designed to perform specialized spinal surgery and other neurological treatments. The Spine Clinic will provide continuity of care, create a more comprehensive and holistic approach, and bring full-service neurological treatment to the patients in our community.

"We are excited to add this service line to provide support for patients in our community. We are grateful for the generous donation from the Milan Puskar Foundation supporting the purchase of surgical equipment to facilitate the start of this program. We are looking forward to seeing our first patients later this summer," said Dr. Krystal Atkinson, CAO of MHMC and CNO of MHS.
